## P Car Parking

Patients and visitors can use Car Parks 1 4 5a 6 & 10 You must pay on exit at one of the yellow pay stations.

## £ Financial Help

Patients receiving income support, income-based jobseeker's allowance and pension credit guarantee credits, as well as those with a valid NHS tax credit exemption certificate can claim free parking. You must get your appointment card signed, provide proof of claim to reception and Patient Accounts will refund your ticket.

## ♿ Disabled Parking

Disabled drivers can use Car Parks 2 and 3 free of charge with a blue badge permit and marked roadway spaces around the hospital. You will be liable to pay a fee if you use any of the other car parks.
